



DIRECTIONS

Step 1: To create the leaves and petals use the wire and wire cutters. Shape the wire, leaving a "tail" on both ends to twist and hold the shape. The wire will make it possible to give the flower dimension and personality by bending the petals and leaves. Make 2-3 leaves for each flower.



Step 2: Roving comes in a long hank of strands. To prepare the roving for needle felting, remove a portion of the roving from the hank and begin to pull the roving apart then mesh and blend it by hand. The fibers need to oppose and mesh for the felting process to work.




Step 3: Prepare enough roving fibers to make one petal or leaf. This needs to be $\frac{3}{4}$ "-1" larger than the petal or leaf shape so it can be wrapped around the wire edge.

Step 4: Place the roving on the mat and begin to needle felt the fibers, turn over, needle felt, repeat and turn over again. The fibers should feel like a loosley woven fabric. Place the wire shape onto the roving on the mat. Roll the excess roving (fold if necessary) over the wire and needle

felt in the center. This process will hold and cover the wire frame. Continue to needle felt and turn over as you go until the fibers go from a soft texture to a firm fabric. The goal is firm and compact.

Note: If any wire shows, make a diamond shape piece of felted roving; then place it over the wire edge for attaching front to back. Needle felt to blend.



Step 5: Not all petals get the same amount of light or shadow so you may want to add highlights and shading. Use straight strands of roving and the pen style needle felting tool to add color and detail. If you need to needle felt near the wired edge, go in at a 45° angle, being careful to go slow to avoid breaking the needle. Varigated yarn works very well to define veins on the leaves and adds color to the petals.

FINISHING

Step 1: Use the bent tip scissors to clean up the fuzz on front and back and the sides of the petals and leaves.

Step 2: Decide on the flower center. Choose a button, bead or make a felted bead and insert a wire through the center; fold and twist the wire. If you use Memory Thread and want to decorate it, now is the time to do it.

Step 3: To form the flower start with the center pieces from Step 2, add petals around the center holding all the wire ends. Once all the petals have been added twist the wire to secure the placement. Add the leaves in the same

manner. Add extra wire if needed for security. Fold wires up and into the base.

Step 4: Make a ¼ round circle (pie shape) out of the leaf color roving. This should be tall enough to wrap around the stems and cover. Carefully needle felt in place, overlapping the ends to hold and cover the wire stems. This could also be held in place with buttonhole thread or a ribbon.

Step 5: Attach a pin back if desired with thread or hot glue. Adjust petals and leaves and enjoy!
